Cardamom (Elettaria Cardamomum)

Elettaria cardamomum, commonly known as green or true cardamom, is a herbaceous, perennial plant and is a native to the evergreen rain forests of the Western Ghats in South India. It is cultivated in Kerala, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu.

Species used for cardamom are native throughout tropical and subtropical Asia. The first references to cardamom are found in Sumer, and in the Ayurvedic literature of India.

The typical season begins from June-July and continues till January-February in Kerala and Tamil Nadu. While in Karnataka, harvesting begins in August and prolongs till December- January

Cardamom is used in flavorings and cooking spices in both food and drink, and as a medicine. E. cardamomum (green cardamom) is used as a spice, a masticatory, and in medicine



Cardamom Oil

Cardamom oil is obtained from the seeds of the cardamom plant by the steam distillation method. It is used in medicines.

Its aroma characteristics are spicy, rich, warm, aromatic, and slightly woody.
